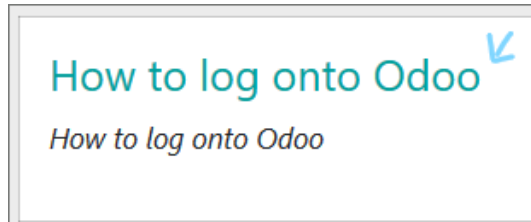
- **Odoo**: web-based package of various business applications (e.g. for project management, accounting, knowledge management, etc.)

When all sections (and sub-sections) are un-ticked, all articles will be displayed in the list of articles. If you select one section, only the articles of that section will be displayed.

Inside the article

To move to another article, click "KnowSystem" button to go back.

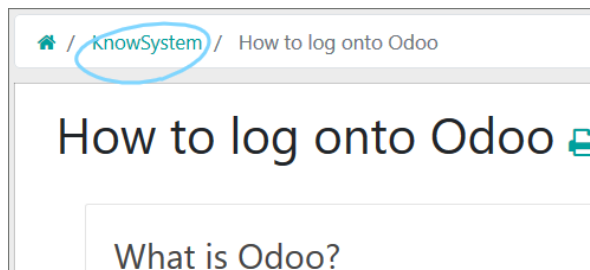
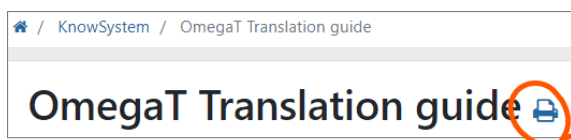


Table of contents
